



Girls 7v7 Rules

RULES OF PLAY:

- (2) 15 min half's / running clock even after goals and within two minutes.
- 60 second timeout for entire game and the clock will continue to run. The players that were on the field before the timeout was called is the team that must return. Players will drop their sticks on the field and return to them after 60 seconds. Thus, no subbing during timeouts. Timeout **CANNOT** be used in the last 5 mins of the second half.
- Yellow card = 2 min penalty
 - (2) yellow cards from same player = 2 min penalty & ejection from game
 - (3) yellow cards to one team = team must play down a player for the duration of the game.
- If a team is up by more than 5 goals at any time, the team that is losing will be allowed to free clear (meaning the goalie will clear it to a player on the field uncontested and the official will signal the start of play once the player has the ball)
- All subs will be "on the fly" unless there is an injury. Even after the 5 goal rule, subs will still be "on the fly". Reminder, no subbing during timeouts.
- • BALLS - All teams are responsible for balls on their offensive end line. Each coach will be provided six (6) balls for the tournament when they check in and then are expected to ensure they use their balls on their offensive end line during games. Our fences and nets will be set up to stop as many balls as possible, but please keep track of your six balls.

SPORTSMANSHIP/CONDUCT:

- Only Head Coaches are permitted to address the officials; and do so in a respectful manner.
- Head Coaches are responsible for any of their clubs unruly players, asst. coaches, and fans.
- The Little Rock LaxFest has a one-strike policy for coaches and players. That being said, the Little Rock LaxFest Staff has the right to remove any coach, player, or fan from the tournament at their discretion. In the event of a warning, coaches and players will be notified and any further incidents will result in that coach or player's removal from the Little Rock LaxFest.
- Poor Sportsmanship, taunting, trash talking, fighting, or other unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated by coaches, players, and fans.

- Referees will notify the Field Coordinator of any warning given to a Coach or Player. Accordingly, the Tournament Directors will be made aware of all incidents throughout the Tournament.
- Coaches who are removed from the Tournament will be reevaluated at the end of the event, at which point their team's acceptance into future Victory Event Series events will be addressed.
- Please speak to a Tournament Director about any problems that may arise during the weekend.
- Respect your team, your opponents and the game.
- Set a good example for your players.
